**SUBJECT:** Title III-B, Older Americans Act Grant for Remote-  
Control Beepers for Sacramento Elderly Nutrition  
Program Vehicles

### SUMMARY

The attached resolution authorizes (1) the acceptance of a Title III-B, Older Americans Act grant for the purchase of remote-control beepers for Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program vehicles, and (2) expenditure of local funds to meet the required local match for this grant.

### BACKGROUND

In February, 1981, the Area 4 Agency on Aging asked for concept papers for one-time-only Title III, Older Americans Act funds available for equipment purchases in FY 1980-81. The Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program submitted concept papers for various equipment, including beepers for its transportation vehicle fleet.

On April 7, 1981, the Area 4 Agency on Aging advised that one-time-only funds would not be made available until July 1, 1981, and on June 15, 1981, the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program received notification that Title III-B funds in the amount of \$500 had been approved for the purchase of the beepers.

The contract period for this special grant was established by the Area 4 Agency on Aging as July 1 through August 31, 1981.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The grant amount of \$500.00. It requires a local match of \$56.00 (County PILOT funds).


