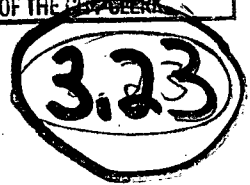
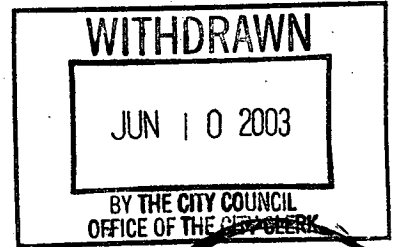

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY PROHIBITION ESTABLISHED BY SUBSECTION C OF ORDINANCE NO. 2002-019 ON THE ACCEPTANCE, PROCESSING, OR APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR SPECIAL PERMITS OR OTHER DISCRETIONARY DEVELOPMENT ENTITLEMENTS FOR SOLID WASTE TRANSFER OR PROCESSING STATIONS AND YARD WASTE COMPOSTING FACILITIES WITHIN THE AREA BOUNDED TO THE NORTH BY THE AMERICAN RIVER AND TO THE SOUTH, EAST, AND WEST BY THE CITY LIMITS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

## SECTION 1.

### Recitals

On June 4, 2002, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2002-019. That ordinance established a temporary prohibition on the acceptance, processing, or approval of applications for special permits or other discretionary development entitlements for solid waste transfer or processing stations and yard waste composting facilities within the area bounded to the north by the American River and to the south, east and west by the City limits.

The temporary prohibition established by Ordinance No. 2002-019 is due to expire on June 10, 2003.

The city is currently processing policies and amendments to the Zoning Code relating to the development of transfer and processing stations and yard waste and composting facilities. These policies and amendments will not be adopted and effective prior to June 19, 2003, and it is therefore necessary to extend the time period of the temporary prohibition established by Ordinance No. 2002-019.

**SECTION 2**

Ordinance No. 2002-019 is amended as follows:

1. Subsection A of Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2002-019 is amended to read as follows:
  - A. Except as provided in Subsection D below, no application for a Special Permit, Special Permit Modification or other discretionary entitlement required by the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance to establish a transfer or processing station, or to establish a yard waste composting facility, for property located within the area of the City bounded to the north by the American River and to the south, east and west by the City limits (as shown on Exhibit 1) shall be accepted, processed or approved until:
    1. September 1, 2003; or
    2. The approval by the City Council, by resolution or ordinance, of policies and implementing legislation concerning the development of transfer or processing stations handling municipal solid waste and yard waste composition facilities.
2. Except as specifically amended by Subsection 1 above, Ordinance No. 2002-019 remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

## SECTION 1.

### Recitals
