SUBJECT: Construction of Vertical Curbs at Seymour Park

SUMMARY

Seymour Park, located at the intersection of Clipper Way and Riverside Boulevard, is the site of increased levels of vehicular vandalism and subsequent damage to the turf. This report recommends that the City Council amend the description of the currently funded Seymour Park South project to include vertical curbs, and appropriate \$5,000 in Quimby fees to cover the construction costs.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Seymour Park South addition is scheduled as part of the 1985-86 capital improvement program. The project involves development of a 4.5 acre extension of Seymour Park to include turf and irrigation.

Staff has met with residents of the area surrounding Seymour Park on several occasions to discuss their concerns regarding the vandalism at the site. Both staff and citizens concur in the recommendation that the construction of vertical curbs around the site would be the most positive solution for the problem.

FINANCIAL DATA


The adopted 1985-86 capital improvement budget for Seymour Park South addition is \$109,000 in Quimby fees. It is recommended that \$5,000 additional funds from the Quimby Act Reserve Fund be appropriated for construction of vertical curbs in FY 1985-86.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee review this report and refer it to the full City Council for approval. Further, it is recommended that the City Council:

1. amend, by resolution, the description of Seymour Park South addition to include vertical curbs at Clipper Way and Riverside Boulevard; and
2. appropriate an additional \$5,000 from the Quimby Act Reserve Fund for the construction of the vertical curbs.
