**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT NO. 057-M FOR THE POWER INN ROAD WIDENING PROJECT (PN:TK11) AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Power Inn Road Widening from Folsom Boulevard to 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Council District 6.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution which:

- Approves Program Supplement No. 057-M for the Power Inn Road Widening Project (PN:TK11); and
- Appropriates \$317,656 in Federal (\$296,260 in RSTP funds and \$21,396 in Demo funds) funds to the project for the engineering design.

**SUMMARY:**

Approval of the Program Supplement is required to receive Federal funds in the amount of \$317,656 for the design phase of the project. Local funds have already been appropriated to the project to cover the City's share of engineering design costs. Staff will return to Council at a future date for approval of additional Federal, State and Local funds for the construction phase of the project.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION:**

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The project is part of an area-wide improvements which will improve operations on the Power Inn Road and Folsom Boulevard corridors and relieve congestion at the intersection of Folsom Boulevard and Power Inn Road. The Power Inn Road Widening project will increase the number of lanes along Power Inn Road between Folsom Boulevard and 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue from four lanes to six lanes and construct traffic signals, lighting, pedestrian, bicycle, landscaping, and median improvements.
- The City has been programmed to receive Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funding for both the design and construction phases of this project. However, a Program Supplement must be approved for each phase in order to expend the fund allocation for that phase. This report approves the Program Supplement for the design phase only.
- The City has received authorization to begin the design phase, which includes the preparation of plans, specifications, and estimate.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS**

The City of Sacramento is the lead agency for CEQA compliance and FHWA is the lead agency for NEPA compliance. The City is preparing a programmatic Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the project. A categorical Exclusion has been prepared for this project.

Because the project is being partially financed with federal highway funds, an environmental analysis is being prepared to satisfy the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The estimated project cost for the Power Inn Road Widening Project is \$4,650,000. Local funds (Measure A) in the amount of \$141,344 and Federal (TEA 21 and Demo) funds in the amount of \$317,656 have been allocated to the project. Staff will return to Council at a future date for approval of the Program Supplement and additional Local, State and Federal funds for the construction phase of the project.


