

ORDINANCE NO. 1061, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND
ABANDONING THAT CERTAIN ALLEY BETWEEN
"B" AND "C" STREETS FROM THE EASTERLY
LINE OF 14TH STREET TO THE WESTERLY LINE
OF 15TH STREET, IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That certain alley in the City
of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California,
between "B" and "C" Streets from the easterly line of
14th Street to the westerly line of 15th Street, is
hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to
repair, maintain and construct sewer, water pipe, gas
pipe and aerial or underground power, telephone and
other communication facilities now in place in said
alley, or which, from time to time, may be necessary
to be placed therein.

Said closing and vacating is declared after
due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a
finding by the City Council, which is hereby made,
that said alley herein described is unnecessary for
present or prospective public street purposes.

ORDINANCE NO. 1062, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THAT CERTAIN ALLEY FIRST WEST OF 35TH STREET, FROM STOCKTON BOULEVARD SOUTHERLY TO THE NORTHERLY LINE OF SERRA WAY, IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That certain alley in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, first west of 35th Street, from Stockton Boulevard southerly to the northerly line of Serra Way, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

RESERVING, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water pipe, gas pipe and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said alley, or which, from time to time, may be necessary to be placed therein.


Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said alley herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.
