**ALLOCATION OF STATE JOBS-HOUSING BALANCE INCENTIVE
GRANT FUNDS TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (M03-
185/BD01)**

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2003, the City Council authorized acceptance of the State Jobs-Housing Balance Incentive Grant to support infill development and neighborhood revitalization (Res. 2003-820); and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved funding projects with the State Jobs-Housing Balance Incentive Grant, including an intent to fund the 65th Street Pedestrian Enhancement Project (Res. 2003-034); and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to provide State Jobs-Housing Balance Incentive Grant funds to eligible parks projects and consider using the General Funds in those accounts to create an Infill Incentive Account (Res. 2003-035)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following CIPs shall be amended to appropriate funds from the State Jobs-Housing Balance Incentive Grant Program (BD01, Fund 512) and transfer funds to BD01 pending future City Council consideration of guidelines for the Infill Incentive Account, as follows:


1. Appropriate \$500,000 from the Jobs-Housing Program CIP (BD01, Fund 512) to the 65th Street Streetscape Improvement Project CIP (TU96) and clarify the CIP description to include reimbursements for construction of improvements by private developers, to include interim landscaping of land dedicated for future travel lanes along Folsom Boulevard and 65th Street, and to potentially include installation of pedestrian scale streetlights.
2. Appropriate \$271,000 from the Jobs-Housing Program CIP (BD01, Fund 512) to the Strauch Park CIP (LS02, Fund 512) and transfer the existing \$271,000 in General Funds in LS02 to BD01;

3. Appropriate \$176,000 from the Jobs-Housing Program CIP (BD01, Fund 512) to the Creekside Park CIP (LS04, Fund 512) and transfer the existing \$176,000 in General Funds in LS04 to BD01; and
4. Appropriate \$310,980 from the Jobs-Housing Program CIP (BD01, Fund 512) to the Parks Water Conservation CIP (LW81, Fund 512) and transfer \$203,000 in General Funds in LW81 to BD01.
