RESOLUTION ACCEPTING Grant DEED

WHEREAS, AMELIA MCKISSON and W. F. WEIGEL

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Grant Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 21 "Amended Map of M. J. Dillman Tract Subdivision No. 1" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, California, on April 3, 1893, in Book 3 of Maps, Map No. 11); which said point is further described as being located south, 78° 48.04' east, 112.96 feet from a monument marking the new center line intersection of 5th Avenue and San Rafael Way, in said City of Sacramento; thence from the point of beginning south, 2° 13.87' east, 12.75 feet along the easterly line of said Lot 21, to a point; thence north, 89° 08.24' west, 39.97 feet along a line parallel to, and distant 33.00 feet at right angles southerly from, the new center line of 5th Avenue, to a point; thence north, 2° 13.87' west, 12.15 feet, to a point on the northerly line of said Lot 21; thence south, 89° 59.51' east, 39.94 feet along the northerly line of said Lot 21, to the point of beginning; and containing 498.00 square feet, more or less.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:
