PROCEEDINGS UNDER NO. 3278




BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That any and all bids received on November 13th, 1958 on the construction of a Water Distribution System, in 29th Avenue from the center line of Franklin Boulevard to the Westerly Boundary of City Farms (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); 28th Street from the Southerly line of 26th Avenue to a point located 215 feet South of the center line of Fruitridge Road; Improving Right of Way along the Easterly 3.00 feet of the South One-Half of the West One-Half of Lot 3 of said City Farms, pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 3278, be, and the same are hereby rejected; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Resolutions approving Map and Diagram, Plans, Grades and Specifications, and Resolution of Intention adopted October 2nd, 1958 and Resolution Ordering Work adopted October 23, 1958, all under said Proceedings No. 3278, be, and the same are hereby rescinded and abandoned.
