


RESOLUTION NO. 2602

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF
November 7th, 1946


WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council requesting that proceedings be adopted for the improvement of the Alley between 1st Avenue and 2nd Avenue from the easterly line of 30th Street to the westerly line of Alhambra Boulevard (formerly 31st Street), in the City of Sacramento, and WHEREAS, the signers of said petition state that they are all of the owners of more than 85% of the area liable for assessment for said work and improvement, and they expressly "WAIVE" the provisions of Division 4 of the "Streets and Highways Code" of the State of California, (The Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation, and Majority Protest Act of 1931), as amended, and all investigations proceedings and reports provided for therein, and WHEREAS, the said petition has been checked by the City Engineer's Office and found that the WAIVER is signed by the owners of more than 85% of the area liable for assessment for said work. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the said petition is hereby approved and granted, and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby finds and determines that the WAIVER in said petition is signed by the owners of more than 85% of the area liable for said work and improvement and hereby directs that proceedings for said work be authorized as provided in Division 7 of the said Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911.
