Aquatic Safety Week July 18-25, 2001

WHEREAS, Aquatic Safety for Kids (A.S.K.) Foundation of Sacramento, California, promotes the KIDSPLASH TWENTY FIRST CENTURY aquatic education safety program to help educate Americans of the significance of aquatic safety, health and fitness; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento and American Rivers are utilized by many swimmers and numerous types of watercraft which makes aquatic safety vital to this community; and

WHEREAS, A.S.K. Foundation, the City of Sacramento Neighborhoods, Planning & Development Services Department, American Medical Response, D.A.R.T., U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, Waterworld USA, California Department of Boating and Waterways, Toyota, American Red Cross, Raley's, and Big 5 continue their role to promote and raise community-wide awareness of aquatic safety; and


