

## **RESOLUTION NO.2019-0280**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 23, 2019

### **Acceptance of California Board of State and Community Corrections Youth Reinvestment Grant Funding to Implement Partnership with the Office of Violence Prevention and Sacramento City Unified School District**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A The City of Sacramento will utilize funding from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) to implement the Lifeline Program for students in 4-8<sup>th</sup> grade. This goal of this project is to disrupt the school-to-prison pipeline in Sacramento by providing wrap around services to students with multiple serious behavioral infractions.
- B. The City of Sacramento has received a Youth Reinvestment grant award in the amount of \$999,780 from the Board of State and Community Correction to provide funding for the Lifeline Program.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is authorized to accept a grant award for the amount of \$999,780, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, from the Board of State and Community Corrections.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish the Youth Reinvestment Grant Project (G02001300).
- Section 3: The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the Youth Reinvestment Grant Project (G02001300) in the amount of \$999,780 (Operating Grant Fund, Fund 2702).
- Section 4. The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish the expenditure budget in Youth Reinvestment Grant Project (G02001300) by transferring \$6,000 (General Fund, Fund 1001) from the Gang Prevention and Intervention Multi-year Operating Project (I02000600) for the City grant match.

Section 5. The City Manager, or City Manager's designee, is authorized to enter into agreements with HAWK Institute, Sacramento City Unified School District and other service providers as appropriate to execute the grant.
