

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-233

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

April 17, 2007

APPROVING PARKS AND RECREATION CAPITAL GRANTS REPROGRAMMING

BACKGROUND

- A. Since 2001, over \$20 million has been secured in State and Federal grant funds for parks and recreation projects for more than 60 projects.
- B. Approximately \$3.9 million is recommended to be reprogrammed at this time to retain and maximize use of the grant funds. Any required matching funds are already budgeted in the Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Program.
- C. Projects recommended for reprogramming are consistent with grant program criteria and timeframes, and leverage funding for current and future parks and recreation capital projects.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an amendment to the Environmental Enhancement Mitigation Program Grant agreement with the California Department of Transportation to reprogram \$250,000 in grant funds to the Ueda Parkway Project (HB19);
- Section 2. Reprogram Environmental Enhancement Mitigation Program, Transportation Development Allocation Fund, Proposition 12 Per Capita, Proposition 12 Roberi-Z'Berg-Harris, Proposition 40 River Parkway, and Proposition 40 Roberti-Z'berg-Harris, and Proposition 40 Per Capita grant funds as detailed in Exhibit A, pg. 9.
