

RESOLUTION No. 647

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of


July 23rd, 1948.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

That SORENSON SOUND SYSTEMS be, and it is hereby, granted a revocable permit to install a private telephone line across the alley extending from 29th Street to 30th Street, between I and J Streets; same to run from a point on the north side of said alley, 58 feet east of the 29th Street property line, to a point on the south side of the alley, 80 feet east of the 29th Street property. Said line to consist of standard outdoor telephone (bridle) wire, #18, three-conductor. Voltage applied to the line in service shall not exceed 24 volts, r.m.s., at 60 cycles with reference to ground. Peak current shall not exceed one ampere. Said line to be maintained 21 feet above alley grade.

This permit is granted upon the condition that SORENSON SOUND SYSTEMS protect and save harmless the City from all damage, costs and causes of action which might arise in the use of said line.

This permit is granted in pursuance of application heretofore filed by said Sorenson Sound Systems.
