

ORDINANCE NO. 1506, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO TO RECONSTRUCT BUILDINGS AT THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT; NEW IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CORPORATION YARD, AND NEW LIGHT FIXTURES AT THE CITY LIBRARY, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager has recommended that the following work be done, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter;

- (a) Reconstruct buildings at the Sacramento Municipal Airport, consisting of a new office, store and hangar building, made necessary by the fact that the former buildings have been condemned. The cost of said work to be \$12,500.00.
- (b) Improvements at the City Corporation Yard, consisting of a new paint storeroom and paint spray room. This work is necessary in order to facilitate the work of the Painting Division of the city. The cost of said work to be \$4500.00.
- (c) Improvements to the City Library, to include new electric fixtures. The cost of said work to be \$1500.00.


That the City Manager is hereby authorized to have the above improvements made; the work to be done by day labor under the direction of said City Manager, or by contract, or by a combination of the two.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of reconstructing buildings at the Sacramento Municipal Airport made necessary by the fact that the former buildings have been condemned; of new improvements at the City Corporation Yard to facilitate the work of the Painting Division of the City; and providing better lighting in the City Library; that a delay of one month would be a serious detriment to all of said work.


