

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION No. 2539

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described should be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of the said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City, to-wit:

To close, vacate and abandon the following described alleys and street:

The alley between X Street and Broadway from the easterly line of 6th Street to the westerly line of 7th Street, and

The alley between X Street and Broadway from the easterly line of 7th Street to the westerly line of 8th Street, and

7th Street from the southerly line of X Street to the northerly line of Broadway.


And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected and benefited by said work and improvement, and that therefore the entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon, said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and the exterior boundaries of the lands affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

On the North by X Street;
On the South by Broadway;
On the West by 6th Street;
On the East by 8th Street.

And the City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of "Division 9, Part 3, Streets and Highways Code", the "Street Vacation Act of 1941", being an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, approved May 13, 1941; and hereby fixes the 28th day of December, 1945, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. in the City Council Chamber in the Sacramento City Hall on I Street, between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place when and where any and all persons interested in said work and improvement may appear before the said City Council of said City and be heard by said City Council upon such appeal, and show cause, if any they have, why the said improvement should not be made.


