SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 86056 TO PROVIDE SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS FOR THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO

SUMMARY

In 1986, the City of Sacramento entered into an agreement to provide adult School Crossing Guards at four locations in the unincorporated area of Sacramento County. In 1987, the agreement was amended to increase the number of Crossing Guards locations to six in the unincorporated area.

The County of Sacramento is now requesting a second amendment to this agreement to provide an additional Crossing Guard for the 88/89 school year. The cost of providing one additional Crossing Guard is \$5,860. The County of Sacramento will reimburse the City for the cost. It is recommended that City Council amend the agreement and authorize the necessary budget adjustments.

BACKGROUND

In September of 1986 the City Council adopted Resolution 86-679 for the City and County of Sacramento to enter into an agreement whereby the City would provide one Senior Crossing Guard and Four Crossing Guards to control school crossings in the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County. The agreement remains in effect until June 30, 1991, unless terminated earlier by either party. Under the terms of the agreement the County reimburses the City for all costs.

In September of 1987 the City Council amended the agreement and added two additional Crossing Guards for the 1987/1988 school year. The County of Sacramento is now requesting a second amendment to the agreement to add one additional Crossing Guard for the 1988/1989 school year for the intersection of Main and Bullion Drive. This will require an additional .44 FTE School Crossing Guard be added to the Police Department Budget.


FINANCIAL DATA

The cost of salary and benefits for an additional .44 FTE of a School Crossing Guard in the 88/89 fiscal year is \$5,860. Under the terms of the agreement this additional cost will be reimbursed by the County of Sacramento.

RECOMMENDATION

This item was heard before the Budget and Finance Committee on September 27, 1988. The committee agreed to forward this request to the City Council for consideration with a recommendation for approval. It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the City Manager to amend the agreement to provide School Crossing Guards in the unincorporated area of Sacramento County. It is further recommended that the Police Department receive an additional .44 FTE in School Crossing Guards and \$5,860 in appropriations.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

- 1) The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, an amendment to the Agreement with the County of Sacramento, in the form hereto attached, to provide School Crossing Guard services at various locations in the unincorporated area of Sacramento County.
- 2) Said amended Agreement remain in effect until June 30, 1991, or until properly terminated by either of the parties.
- 3) The Office of Operations (2123) be increased by .44 F.T.E. for one additional School Crossing Guard.
- 4) The General Fund Revenue Budget for fiscal year 88/89 is amended to include an additional \$5,860 from the County of Sacramento (101-210-2123-3598).
- 5) The General Fund Administrative Contingency is increased by \$5,860 due to the revenue from the County of Sacramento (101-710-7012-4999).
- 6) The General Fund Administrative Contingency (101-710-7012-4999) is reduced to transfer \$5,860 to the Police Department Traffic Section (101-210-2123-4XXX) to provide a School Crossing Guard in the unincorporated area of Sacramento County.


SUMMARY


RECOMMENDATION
