MINUTES:

Frank Mugartegui, the Director of General Services, gave the Committee a detailed overview on the space needs for the Corporation Yard. The desirable goal is to have all the corporation yards that the City owns consolidated to one site. He explained that transportation is the drawing magnet and that the optimum location was near Broadway and 99. He explained that the City would find the consolidation of the seven existing corporation yards into one site very cost effective.

Gary Szydelko, Senior Architect, gave the Committee a detailed report on the facility requirements.

The Committee generally agreed that it would not be possible to pick a central location for the corporation yard until the site for the transfer station was chosen.
