

# RESOLUTION NO. 2003-678

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF SEP 30 2003

RESOLUTION CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF A PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2004, AND OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2004, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS (DISTRICTS 2, 4, 6, 8, AND THE OFFICE OF MAYOR) AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO CHARTER CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to charter cities in the State of California, a Primary Municipal Election shall be held on March 2, 2004, and a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 2, 2004, for the election of Municipal Officers;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to charter cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Sacramento, California, on Tuesday, March 2, 2004, a Primary Municipal Election, and on Tuesday, November 2, 2004, a General Municipal Election, for the purpose of electing four members of the City Council (Districts 2, 4, 6, 8), and the Office of MAYOR for the full term of four years.

SECTION 2. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 3. That the polls for the election shall be open at 7:00 a.m. on the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 4. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

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SECTION 5. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
