SUBJECT: Consultant Services Agreement for the Hagginwood Creek  
Study (WC26)

SUMMARY

The Public Works Department, Flood Control and Sewer Division, has completed interviews with five engineering firms for the Hagginwood Creek Study. The firm of Dewante and Stowell was ranked the highest with Nolte and Associates as second choice. It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to negotiate an agreement with Dewante and Stowell or with Nolte and Associates should negotiations with Dewante and Stowell prove unproductive.

BACKGROUND

Although the Hagginwood Creek drainage complex has some obvious deficiencies, there has been no in depth study as to the best and most economical solution to these problems. The engineering staff is therefore recommending that a consultant study be undertaken to identify the most effective and economical plan to improve drainage in the Hagginwood Creek area.

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In response to the City's request for proposals five engineering firms submitted proposals for the study. On June 21, 1988 all five firms were interviewed by a selection panel composed of the following members:

- Don Dodge, Deputy Public Works Director, City of Sacramento
- Terry Paxton, Supervising Engineer, City of Sacramento
- Dee Lewis, Supervising Engineer, City of Sacramento
- Bruce Barboza, Associate Engineer, City of Sacramento
- Richard Ransom, Associate Engineer, County of Sacramento

The five firms who submitted proposals and who were interviewed are as follows:

- Nolte & Associates
- Dewante and Stowell, Inc.
- The Spink Corporation
- Robert E. Young and Associates
- John Corollo Engineers

The criteria used to evaluate the consultants qualifications and presentation were as follows:

1. General drainage study experience
2. Expertise in hydrology, hydraulics and design
3. Experience on similar studies
4. Evaluation of project approach and objectives
5. Understanding of the project
6. Project approach
7. Project manager's experience
8. Clearness of presentation

Based upon the proposals and subsequent interviews, the selection panel recommends that the firm of Dewante and Stowell be selected as the engineer for this study with Nolte and Associates as an alternate should negotiations with Dewante and Stowell prove unproductive.

FINANCIAL


There is currently \$100,000 budgeted from Storm Drainage funds (425) for the Hagginwood Creek Study (Project WC26). It is anticipated that the cost of the study will be less than this amount therefore no additional funding is requested.

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RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to negotiate an agreement with Dewante and Stowell for the Hagginwood Creek Study with Nolte and Associates as alternate should negotiations with Dewante and Stowell prove unproductive.


