**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID, AND CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE FRANKLIN BOULEVARD AND CALVINE ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT (PN: SJ31)**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Franklin Boulevard and Calvine Road. Council District 8.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the plans and specifications;
- Accept the bid of M&M Electric in the amount of \$149,969; and
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for the Franklin Boulevard and Calvine Road Traffic Signal project.

**SUMMARY:**

This project will install a new traffic signal at the intersection of Franklin Boulevard and Calvine Road. Interconnect cable will be installed, in existing conduit, from Calvine Road to Ehrhardt Avenue along Franklin Boulevard for traffic signal coordination. In addition, this project will include pedestrian facilities and civil improvements such as new handicap ramps, intersection widening on Calvine Road and modification of the median islands at this intersection.

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**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- This project was authorized in the 1994/95 Capital Improvement Program.
- Additional work arose during the design phase of this project which included the widening of Calvine Road at Franklin Boulevard and the modification of two landscaped median islands on Franklin Boulevard. This work was necessary to facilitate the traffic flow though this intersection.
- This project was advertised and bids were received on May 15, 1996 and are summarized below:

- The construction estimate is \$182,500.
- M&M Electric met the good faith effort.
- Approval of the plans and specifications and award to M&M Electric is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The project budget for Franklin Boulevard and Calvine Road is \$175,000.
- The unobligated fund balance is sufficient for award.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has determined that this project is exempt from CEQA per State Class 1 and 2 and Section Number 15301(c) and 15303(c).

A notice of categorical exemption was filed for this project on April 4, 1996.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 58.

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**MBE/WBE EFFORTS:**

To encourage minority participation, plans and specifications were sent to 9 plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication. Four are directly involved with MBE/WBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available MBE/WBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was announced on the Project Information Line which contains information on Public Works and Utility Department projects. Project notices were sent to 29 organizations involved in MBE/WBE recruitment.


