

RESOLUTION NO. 706

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
November 19, 1948

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF SACRAMENTO:

That THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY be granted a revocable permit to construct an extension of its existing passing track at South Sacramento, westerly across 12th Avenue (Sutterville Road) in the City of Sacramento, subject to the condition that should it be necessary to build a subway in the future across 12th Avenue, the Company agrees to pay its share of that portion of the cost properly chargeable to this passing track.

That the description of the said extension of said passing track is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the southerly line of 12th Avenue, said point being distant 55.0 feet easterly, measured at right angles from the easterly line of Terminal Avenue; also distant 15.0 feet easterly, measured at right angles from the center line of main line of the Western Pacific Railroad and parallel to said center line of main line; thence crossing 12th Avenue at an angle of approximately 87° to a point on the north line of 12th Avenue; thence into private property.

That the foregoing permit is granted in accordance with application and blueprint filed October 9, 1948, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 237 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, at no expense whatsoever to said City of Sacramento.
