Inasmuch as this date had been set for the purpose of holding an examination, reading of the minutes was dispensed with.


STENOGRAPHER EXAM. #113

Written Exam. Held



During the course of the examination, the Board members discussed the appointment of Mr. Lyle Lack as Service Station Attendant, Mr. Lack having been certified from the Laborer list for this employment. He has been employed continuously and satisfactorily since August 26, 1936. After discussion of Mr. Lack's duties and fitness for the position and qualifications, Mr. Deise moved that he be given a classification of Service Station Attendant; seconded by Mr. Cavanaugh, thereupon becoming the order of the Board.
