**SUBJECT:** Approval of Plans and Specifications for WASTE REMOVAL  
FLEET MAINTENANCE BUILDING also Tire Storage Building

SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the above project, a copy of which has been forwarded to the City Clerk. Approval of said plans and specifications is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

This project includes constructing two prefabricated metal buildings at the City Waste Removal Yard. The buildings will provide an enclosed storage area for tires and will shelter tire changing and repair operations for the City's fleet of waste removal trucks.

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y 1979/80 the City Council approved \$45,000.00 for this project in the Equipment Maintenance Division's budget. As of June 27, 1980 the amount available for this project is \$43,564.00. The current estimated cost of the project is \$65,640.00 including engineering and contingencies. Although the engineer's estimate exceeds the amount budgeted, no additional appropriation will be requested until receipt of bids.


