

ORDINANCE NO. 1025, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1014, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 5, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1014, Fourth Series, passed July 14, 1944, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered Section 5:

Section 5: There is hereby appropriated out of the available revenues, not included in the annual 1944-45 budget, the sum of \$10,000.00, to be used for the purpose of drawing plans for such post-war projects as shall be deemed necessary by the City Manager.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary that the drawing of such plans be started immediately.
