

RESOLUTION NO. 1105

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of
December 29, 1939

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento fixed the 15th day of December, 1939, at 8:15 o'clock P. M. in the City Council Chamber as the time and place when interested parties could appear before said Council and show cause why bonds should not be issued upon the security of the unpaid assessments levied by the Superintendent of Streets for the cost of the improvements done pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 2359, at which time the said hearing was duly and properly held and completed, no objections having been offered; and at said meeting the Superintendent of Streets presented a resolution providing for the issuance of street improvement bonds and prescribing the denominations thereof, which resolution was adopted by the City Council on said date of December 15, 1939; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution Prescribing Bonds No. 2359 described the total amount of unpaid assessments as \$16,795.81, when the actual unpaid amount was and is \$18,141.27, the difference of \$1345.46 being the amount to be paid by the City of Sacramento;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the said Resolution Prescribing Bonds No. 2359 adopted by the said City Council at its meeting held December 15, 1939, be, and the same is, hereby rescinded, and that the following Resolution Prescribing Bonds No. 2359 be, and the same is, hereby adopted as a substitute therefor, to-wit:
