- I. The meeting was called to order at 3:40 p.m.
- II. The minutes of the April 15, 1993 meeting were reviewed and approved as written.
- III. **Action Item**
 - A. **Addition to APP Panelist Pool**

Committee reviewed resume of artist Cheryl Riley for consideration as a addition to the panelist pool. Motion was made to add artist Cheryl Riley to the APP panelist pool (M/S: Nielsen/Van Fleet). Motion passed unanimously: Ayes-6, Noes-0.
- IV. **Discussion Items**
 - A. **Video Viewing**

Committee viewed several videotapes produced by different companies and agencies to get an idea of the range of production styles. It was agreed that a videotape for APP promotion/education needed to have upbeat music, move quickly from scene to scene, have a professional voice over, and be no longer than 60 seconds. N.
