Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of
August 12, 1937

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT DEED

WHEREAS, VITA CALICA and ROSA CALICA, his wife,

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Grant Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 22 "Sunset Addition" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County, California, on May 10, 1907, in Book 8 of Maps, Map No. 26); which said point is further described as being located north, $79^{\circ} 46.87'$ east, 78.69 feet from a monument marking the new center line intersection of Santa Cruz Way and 5th Avenue, in said City of Sacramento; thence from the point of beginning north, $2^{\circ} 10.99'$ west, 18.94 feet along the westerly line of said Lot 22, to a point; thence south, $89^{\circ} 08.24'$ east, 40.03 feet along a line parallel to, and distant 33.00 feet at right angles northerly from, the new center line of said 5th Avenue, to a point on the easterly line of said Lot 22; thence south, $2^{\circ} 10.44'$ east, 18.40 feet along the easterly line of said Lot 22, to the southeast corner thereof; thence north, $89^{\circ} 53.48'$ west, 40.00 feet along the southerly line of said Lot 22, to the point of beginning; and containing 747.00 square feet, more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Grant Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Grant Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
