

Resolution of Award No. 2120

Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento, having in open session on the **23rd** day of **September**, **1926**, opened, examined, and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the doing of the street work hereinafter mentioned,

Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **McGILLIVRAY CONSTRUCTION CO.**

at the prices specified in **its** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the improvement of **the northerly portion of "H" Street, from the westerly curb line of 54th Street to a point 201 feet westerly therefrom; and the westerly portion of 54th Street, from the northerly line of "H" Street to a point 400 feet northerly therefrom,**

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2120**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **August 19**, **1926**, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.
