

RESOLUTION No. 53

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
May 13th 1926

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that the Sacramento Plumbing Supply Company be granted revocable permit to establish spur tracks on R Street between 7th and 8th Streets, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of the present track on R Street, said point being on easterly line of 7th Street and 40.0 feet southerly from the northerly line of R Street; thence thru a frog, making an angle of 8° 10' left with the center line of track on R Street, a distance of 75.0 feet to a point; thence along a curve concave to the left with radius of 286.84 feet, an arc distance of 33.0 feet to a point; thence along a curve, concave to the right, with radius of 286.84 feet, an arc distance of 74.1 feet to a point; thence continuing along a line tangent to last mentioned curve and parallel to and 31.5 feet northerly of center line track on R Street, a distance of 65.0 feet to a point approximately 31.5 feet northerly to the center line of R Street and approximately 80.0 feet west of the west line of 8th Street.

in accordance with Petition filed on this date, and blueprint No. 7298 is hereby granted under provisions of Section 237 of the City Charter, at no expense whatsoever to the City of Sacramento.
