RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT DEED

WHEREAS, WILLIAM G. DOWLE and LOTTIE DOWLE, his wife,

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Grant Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of Lot 31, Block 58, as shown on the official plat of "Sub-division E of Oak Park" recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, California, on March 7, 1896, in Book A of Surveys, Survey No. 31; which said point is further described as being located South $1^{\circ} 34.25'$ East, 55.81 feet from a monument marking the original center line intersection of Sacramento Boulevard and 5th Avenue, in the City of Sacramento; thence from the point of beginning South $34^{\circ} 05.87'$ East, 104.73 feet, along a line parallel to, and distant 30.00 feet at right angles southwesterly from, the original center line of said Sacramento Boulevard, to a point; thence North $38^{\circ} 35.87'$ West, 99.10 feet, to a point on the westerly line of said Lot 31; thence North $18^{\circ} 32.86'$ East, 9.77 feet, along the westerly line of said Lot 31, to the point of beginning; and containing 425.00 square feet, more or less;


for the purpose of widening Sacramento Boulevard.

That the said Grant Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Grant Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
