

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION EXPRESSING  
DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY TO PROCEED  
WITH PROCEEDINGS FOR IMPROVEMENT NO. 3482

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento, State of California did on the 19th day of January, 1961, adopt its Resolution Expressing Determination of Legislative Body to Proceed with Proceedings for Improvement No. 3482 ordering that proceedings be undertaken for the construction of a Water Distribution System, complete in Willow Street lying between the center line of 16th Avenue and a point located 483.56 feet Northerly therefrom, in the City of Sacramento, and

Whereas, said resolution did state that the total amount to be assessed upon the lots or parcels of land for the costs and expenses of said proposed improvement would not exceed the limitation of indebtedness established and set forth in the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931", and

Whereas, this Council is of the opinion that the total amount upon the lots and parcels of land to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses of said proposed improvements will exceed the limitation of indebtedness set forth in said "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931".

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved, found and determined by this Council that said Resolution Expressing Determination of Legislative Body to Proceed With Proceedings For Improvement No. 3482 adopted by this Council January 19th, 1961, be amended as follows:

1. That paragraph No. 3 of said Resolution be deleted in entirety.

2. That the following paragraph be added to said Resolution,  
to-wit:

That the estimated total amount proposed to be assessed upon any and all lots or parcels of land for the costs and expenses of said proposed improvement will cause the limitation of indebtedness established and set forth in said Act above referred to, to be exceeded; and that it is the intention of this Council that said limitation shall be exceeded in accordance with the provisions of said Act.
