**SUBJECT: COSUMNES RIVER BOULEVARD CALVINE ROAD INTERCHANGE AT STATE ROUTE 99  
(PN:TJ88) – APPROVAL OF FREEWAY MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Cosumnes River Boulevard/Calvine Road at State Route 99, District 8.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which approves a freeway maintenance agreement with Caltrans.

**SUMMARY:**

The Freeway Maintenance Agreement outlines the maintenance responsibilities of the City, County and Caltrans for the subject project.

Under this agreement, the city is responsible for maintenance of the pavement and street lighting along Cosumnes River Boulevard between Bruceville Road and the centerline of State Route 99. Caltrans is responsible for the maintenance of the underside of the bridge over State Route 99 and all entrance and exit ramps to Cosumnes

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Freeway Maintenance Agreement outlines the maintenance responsibilities of the City, County and Caltrans for the subject project.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

The Cosumnes River Boulevard/Calvine Road at State Route 99 Interchange was funded 100% by City and County Measure A funds.

The project has relieved traffic congestion in the south area and has promoted economic development adjacent to the interchange.

Approval of a Freeway Maintenance Agreement is a routine procedure anytime a new facility is added to the state highway system.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

It is estimated that we will spend, on average, \$6,000 annually to maintain this street to City standards. As with any new facility, the maintenance cost has to be absorbed in our annual maintenance budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The subject of this report does not require compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**




