

ORDINANCE NO. 2047, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF A TELEPHONE FRANCHISE TO THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, A CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, BY THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, TO CONSTRUCT, ERECT, PLACE, LAY, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE POLES, WIRES, CABLES, CONDUITS AND OTHER APPARATUS AND APPLIANCES FOR TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND OTHER COMMUNICATION PURPOSES WITHIN THE CITY UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 1740, FOURTH SERIES, FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS FROM AND AFTER MAY 14, 1958.

WHEREAS, THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a corporation, is the holder of a certain Telephone franchise, granting to it and its successors and assigns, the right, franchise and privilege to construct, erect, place, lay, maintain, and operate poles, wires, cables, conduits and other apparatus and appliances for telephone, telegraph and other communication purposes in, upon, over, across, and under the streets, alleys, avenues, thoroughfares, public highways, public lands, waters and other public areas, now embraced within the corporate boundaries of the City of Sacramento, State of California, which was within the corporate boundaries of said city on May 19, 1905, for a term of FIVE YEARS (5 Years) beginning May 15, 1953 and terminating May 14, 1958, and which said franchise is now in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, said franchise is about to expire, and it is for the best interests of the City of Sacramento that said franchise be extended under the same terms and conditions as therein provided for a term of FIVE YEARS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the application by the Telephone Company for an extension of its franchise, the City of Sacramento does hereby extend the said Telephone franchise now held by it for a period of FIVE YEARS, from and after May 14, 1958, under the same terms and conditions as are now in effect as set forth in ORDINANCE NO. 1740, FOURTH SERIES, of the City of Sacramento, passed May 14, 1953.


SECTION 2. Section No. 9 of Ordinance No. 1740, Fourth Series, is hereby amended to read as follows: The right, franchise and privilege hereby granted shall continue to be in force for a period of FIVE YEARS from and after May 14, 1958.

SECTION 3. That the performance bond as provided for in Section No. 7 of said Ordinance may be continued in force.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published once in the Sacramento Union, the official newspaper of the City, within ten (10) days after its passage, and said ordinance shall take effect on May 14, 1958.
