

# RESOLUTION No. 810

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 12 1937

WHEREAS, a Consolidated Regular and Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1937, pursuant to provisions of Resolution No. 708, adopted by the City Council on date of August 5, 1937, at which a certain Referendum Proposition was submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the vote and returns of said election have this day been canvassed by the City of Sacramento convening as a Canvassing Board and the results thereof duly ascertained.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND DECLARED that the total number of votes cast by the electors at said election for and against the following Referendum Proposition, being the only Referendum Proposition submitted to the voters at such election, viz:
