Hereby rejects all of said bids, except that next hereinafter mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for said work to the lowest regular, responsible bidder, to-wit:

To **Merwin & Gatejen**

at the prices specified in **their** proposal for said work now on file.

The work herein referred to is the ~~improvement~~ installation of a street lighting system complete on Dudley Way from the Easterly line of San Luis Court to the Easterly Boundary of Merkley Tract (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder),

in the City of Sacramento to the extent, with the materials and in the manner set forth in Resolution of Intention No. **2803**, passed and adopted by said City Council on **July 6th** 1950, reference to which Resolution of Intention is hereby made for a description of said work and improvement.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of this award twice in the **Sacramento Union** a daily newspaper published and circulated in said City of Sacramento, as required by law.
