

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-455

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 26, 2007

AWARDING CONTRACT: PURCHASE ONE ROADWAY STRIPER

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Transportation, Street Services Division, Traffic Signs and Marking section, has a need for one roadway striper. The current striper was purchased used and is currently non-operational. It is not repairable at a reasonable cost for the age of the equipment (twenty-two years).
- B. In May, 2007, the City issued a formal Invitation to Bid (B0711811008) for one roadway striper. Three bidders responded. The lowest responsible and responsive bidder was Western Truck Parts and Equipment.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Award a contract to Western Truck Parts and Equipment, 1441 Richards Boulevard, Sacramento, CA 95814, the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, for the purchase of one Roadway Striper in an amount not to exceed \$207,319.


