SUBJECT: Island Construction at T Street and 39th Street

SUMMARY

After public meetings and response, the staff is requesting funds to install traffic islands on all legs of the intersection of T Street and 39th Street.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In the late summer of 1979, a public meeting was held with residents from the T Street and 39th Street area. After the public meeting, a questionnaire was prepared and sent out to the residents. About half of the 270 questionnaires were returned and four items were presented to the residents:

- (1) Traffic Islands at T and 39th Streets.
- (2) Traffic Circles along T Street at 45th, 48th and 55th Streets.
- (3) Bicycle Lanes along T Street
- (4) Traffic Chokers along T Street on the approaches to the island.

The questionnaire results indicated that the majority of the respondents favored three of the four items; these were the islands at T and 39th Streets along with the bike lanes and the traffic circles.

Subsequent discussions were held with Councilman Douglas Pope and Citizens Assistant Officer Walt Thompson on this matter. The status of this project was reviewed with the area residents who attended a public meeting held at the Coloma School on April 3, 1980. The residents indicated their support for these projects at that time. The temporary traffic circles and bicycle lanes will be installed this summer using previously allocated funding for this division.

RECOMMENDATION



RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1979-80 BY TRANSFERRING \$3,000 TO THE STREET MAINTENANCE DIVISION FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND BALANCE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. The installation of traffic islands has been recommended by City Staff and approved by the Budget and Finance Committee. This installation is recommended on the basis of citizen hearings on April 3, 1980.
2. The City Budget for fiscal year 1979-80 is hereby amended by transferring \$3,000 from the unappropriated General Revenue Sharing Fund balance to the Street Maintenance Division of the City Engineering Department (2-11-2600-8049-4820) for the purpose stated in paragraph 1.
