BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

There are approximately six hundred-fifty (650) obsolete and/or substandard fire hydrants in the central city area bounded by "A" Street, Alhambra Boulevard, Broadway, and Front Street. The "Fire Hydrant Replacement Project (ZD51)" is an ongoing project to replace a portion of these hydrants each year. This project involves the replacement of twenty-five (25) existing substandard/obsolete fire hydrants in a developed area, specifically bounded by "P" Street, "W" Street, 21st Street and 29th Street.

On November 24, 1992, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received from twenty-five contractors and opened by the City Clerk on December 30, 1992. The bids received were:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$62,500.00. The estimated project completion date is April 30, 1993.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs is \$75,000. The current budget is \$102,500, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Water funds (413). The amount currently available for the project is \$102,377 as of January 4, 1993.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The action recommended in this report, to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, is consistent with the Public Contract Code of the State of California and with the City Code (Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304).

MBE/WBE EFFORTS:


Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors.

The Department of Utilities is attempting to increase the outreach to MBE/WBE firms. The Department will be announcing projects on the "Construction Bid Line" and will be providing project plans and specifications to the new City sponsored plan room for MBE/WBE firms which will be established in the very near future.



Bid No. 1549: Sufficient funds are available in the Fire Department's budget line 101-250-2532-4445 for hose and fittings when augmented by funds from the Pacific Fire Protection District contract.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS
