RULES AND REGULATIONS

After reconsidering amendments proposed

August 3, 1938, Mr. Cavanaugh moved that

the following amendment to Rule V, Sec-

tion 12, be adopted; seconded by Mr. Deise and unanimously carried...

(Amend by adding the following:)

"When an employee's service in any classification is not consecutive, he will be considered to have completed his probationary period if he has worked six months in the classification during his employment year. The employee's employment year is to be determined by his first appointment from the list."

After discussing the proposed amendment to Rule VIII, Section 4, dated August 3, 1938; Mr. Deise moved that same be adopted; seconded by Mr. Cavanaugh and unanimously carried.

(Amend by adding following:)

"Any regularly certified permanent employee, who has been appointed to an exempt position and has been continuously employed in the City service, and whose service in such exempt position is terminated without cause upon the part of the employee, his name shall be placed on the reinstatement list of his former classification. In computing the employee's seniority, time served in the exempt classification shall be counted as time served in his prior classification."
