
SUMMARY:


RECOMMENDATION:

SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Sewer Replacement in the Former Alley in the Block Bounded by Capitol Avenue, N Street, 29th and 30th Streets

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the subject project have been prepared and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The existing vitrified clay sewer line is in a deteriorating condition and requires replacement. The sewer line is located under the I-80 freeway through the bus parking lot utilized by Regional Transit. Regional Transit has approved the project and the State Department of Transportation has issued an encroachment permit for the work.


FINANCIAL:

The estimated total cost for the project is \$16,550. It is proposed that the monies required for the construction of the project be transferred from the Miscellaneous Sewer Fund. However, it is believed that bids should be received and analyzed before a final budgetary appropriation is recommended to the City Council.


RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and the project advertised for bid upon approval of the City Council.
