

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NUMBER 2128.

Pursuant to the authority of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, providing for the improvement of public streets, avenues, lanes, alleys, courts, places and rights-of-way, forming the exterior boundaries of any municipality, whether partly, or wholly, within or without said boundaries, or extending into the territory of two or more municipalities, or extending into the territory of one or more municipalities and unincorporated territory, and providing for the construction of sewers, drains and drainage systems therein, and to assess the cost thereof upon private property, approved April 21, 1911, and the several Acts amendatory thereof;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:-

That North "B" Street, from a point twelve (12) feet east of the center line of 5th Street, if the same were produced northerly, to the center line of 18th Street, be improved by constructing a sewer, to be of vitrified ironstone pipe, from a point twelve (12) feet east of the center line of 5th Street to a point twelve (12) feet east of the center line of 7th Street; and precast reinforced concrete, from a point twelve (12) feet east of the center line of 7th Street to a point twelve (12) feet east of the center line of 14th Street; and monolithic reinforced concrete sewer from a point twelve (12) feet east of the center line of 14th Street to the center line of 18th Street; and

That 18th Street, from the center line of North "B" Street to a point four (4) feet south of the center line of the alley between "A" and "B" Streets, be improved by constructing a monolithic reinforced concrete sewer; constructing manholes; placing crushed rock; and removing tree.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with plans and specifications adopted for doing said work, and now on file in the office of the City Engineer.

And, whereas, in the opinion of said City Council, said work is of more than local and ordinary public benefit, said Council here by

orders that the costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be chargeable and charged upon a district of lands, which district is hereby declared to be the district benefited by said work and improvement, and which is to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof.

The exterior boundaries of said district, and the extent of the territory included therein, are shown upon a map of said district adopted and approved by the City Council of the City of Sacramento on October 21st, 1926, which map is now on file in the office of the City Engineer, and to which reference is hereby made for a particular description of the boundaries of said district, and of the extent of the territory included therein.

Said district is situated partly in the City of Sacramento and partly in unincorporated territory of the County of Sacramento, and is bounded as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of "B" Street, of the City of Sacramento, with the center line of 18th Street; thence northerly, from the point of beginning, along the center line of said 18th Street, to the northerly line of North "B" Street, said point being on the northerly boundary line of the City of Sacramento; thence continuing northerly, along the center line of 18th Street, produced northerly, 381.40 feet; thence westerly, along a line parallel to, and distant 381.40 feet at right angles northerly from, the northerly line of said North "B" Street, to its intersection with the center line of 13th Street, of the City of Sacramento, produced northerly; thence northerly, along the northerly production of the center line of said 13th Street, 421.40 feet; thence easterly, along a line parallel to, and distant 802.80 feet at right angles northerly from, the northerly line of said North "B" Street, to its intersection with the northwesterly line of Auburn Boulevard; thence northeasterly, along the northwesterly line of said Auburn Boulevard, to its intersection with the center line of 14th Street, of the City of Sacramento, produced northerly; thence northerly, along the northerly production of the

center line of said 14th Street, to a point 1434.90 feet northerly from the northerly line of said North "B" Street; thence westerly, along a line parallel to, and distant 1434.90 feet at right angles northerly from, the northerly line of said North "B" Street, to its intersection with the center line of 12th Street, of the City of Sacramento, produced northerly; thence southerly, along the northerly production of the center line of said 12th Street, 632.10 feet; thence westerly, along a line parallel to, and distant 802.80 feet at right angles northerly from, the northerly line of said North "B" Street, to its intersection with the center line of 7th Street, of the City of Sacramento, produced northerly; thence northerly, along the northerly production of the center line of said 7th Street, to its intersection with the southerly toe of the south Levee of the American River; thence, following the meanderings of the southerly toe of the south Levee of the American River, downstream, to a point distant 700 feet at right angles westerly from the northerly production of the center line of said 7th Street; thence southerly, along a line parallel to, and distant 700 feet at right angles westerly from, the northerly production of the center line of said 7th Street to its intersection with the easterly production of the northerly line of the lands now, or formerly, owned by Chas. Miles, a distance of 1990 feet, more or less; thence westerly, along the easterly production of, and the northerly line of, the lands now, or formerly, owned by Chas. Miles, to the easterly toe of the east Levee of the Sacramento River; thence, following the meanderings of the said easterly toe of the east Levee of the Sacramento River, downstream a distance of 1950 feet, more or less, to its intersection with the southerly line of the lands owned by the City of Sacramento; thence N., $83^{\circ} 33'$ E., along the southerly line of the lands owned by the City of Sacramento, to the southeasterly corner thereof; thence, continuing N., $83^{\circ} 35'$ E., 850 feet to a point; thence N., $65^{\circ} 51'$ E., 144.10 feet to a point; thence N., $57^{\circ} 48' 30''$ E.,

551.50 feet to a point; thence N., 78° 51' E., 92.54 feet, to the southerly line of the aforesaid North "B" Street; thence easterly, along the southerly line of said North "B" Street, to its intersection with the northerly toe of the North Levee of the City of Sacramento; thence, following the meanderings of the said north toe of the said North Levee of the City of Sacramento, easterly to its intersection with the northerly line of said "B" Street, of the City of Sacramento; thence easterly, along the northerly line of said "B" Street, to the center line of the aforesaid 18th Street, the point of beginning.

Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent assessments of \$25.00, or over, and bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per cent per annum, will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "An Act to provide a system of street improvement bonds to represent certain assessments for the cost of street work and improvement within municipalities, and also for the payment of such bonds," approved February 27, 1893, and all acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto. Said bonds shall be serial, and shall extend from their date to and over a period of nine (9) years from the 2nd day of January next succeeding their date; provided that an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the 2nd day of January every year after their date until the whole is paid; and provided, further, that the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupon on the 2nd days of January and July, respectively, of each year after their date, at the rate aforesaid, on all sums unpaid and until the whole of said principal and interest are fully paid.

And notice is hereby given that all persons objecting to said work, or to the extent of the district of lands declared to be benefited, are required to file their objections in writing, in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law,

within ten (10) days after the expiration of the time of the publication and posting of the notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to post this Resolution conspicuously for two (2) days near the door of the Council Chamber of the City Council; also, to publish the same for two (2) days in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law.

The Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, is hereby designated as the paper in which to publish the Notice required by law to be published by the Superintendent of Streets of said City, in relation to the work described aforesaid.


