Subject: Approval of a Traffic Signal and Intersection Lighting Maintenance Agreement with the County of Sacramento and Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute the Agreement on Behalf of the City

SUMMARY

The Maintenance Agreement with the County of Sacramento for the Maintenance of Traffic Signals and Intersection Lighting at City/County boundaries has expired. It is recommended that the current maintenance procedure be continued and the attached Traffic Signals and Intersection Lighting Maintenance Agreement be approved and the attached resolution be passed authorizing the City Manager to execute this agreement on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND

There are several traffic signal intersections on or near the City/County boundary, some of which are maintained by the County of Sacramento and some are maintained by the City of Sacramento. These intersections are listed on the attached schedule.

This agreement provides for the County of Sacramento and the City of Sacramento to pay their proportionate share of the said traffic signal and intersection lighting maintenance cost.

FINANCIAL

The City's share of the annual maintenance cost to be paid to the County is estimated to be \$1269.26 and the County's share of the maintenance cost to be paid to the City is estimated to be \$1093.84.

This amount has been budgeted in the 1980-1981 Facility Maintenance Traffic Signal Activity under Facility Maintenance 1426 fund.




Dear Mrs. Poohar:
