FLORENCE TURTON CLUNIE


WHEREAS, since the assembly of the City Council in its last regular session, this body has been apprized of the last Will and Testament of one of Sacramento's most beloved and friendly residents, MRS. FLORENCE TURTON CLUNIE, a pioneer Sacramentan, bequeathing to this City a Memorial Fund in the sum of \$150,000.00, with which to erect, under the direction of the City Council, a Club House for Women and Children and the installation of a Swimming Pool for the use of the public, both improvements to be constructed in McKinley Park,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby express its profound sorrow in the irreparable loss to our community of this gracious and honored citizen; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council also hereby publicly records the deepest gratitude of the citizenry of the City of Sacramento, which have by this bequest become the recipients of such abundant generosity; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council does also hereby most heartily commend the altruistic thoughtfulness of the donor in determining the nature and purpose of these useful gifts to our People, the benefits, comfort and pleasure emanating from the "FLORENCE TURTON CLUNIE MEMORIAL" so gratefully to be enjoyed by her posterity in this City will ever perpetuate, respect and memorialize the name and worthy deeds of our admired and charitably-spirited citizens, MRS. FLORENCE TURTON CLUNIE, deceased.
