



RESOLUTION INVITING STATE AND LOCAL REPRESENTATIVES TO VISIT SCHOOLS DURING PUBLIC SCHOOLS WEEK

WHEREAS we are represented in state and local government by men and women who share our responsibility for providing school children and young adults with a truly good and sufficient education, both for the fulfillment of their individual lives and for the preservation of our republic; and

WHEREAS we and our representatives need always to make an informed judgment of the way to proceed in order to insure to every student the means of learning not only how best to survive but also how best to contribute to the common good; and

WHEREAS we and our representatives now face a crisis in our school system, which is reflected in numerous legislative and administrative proposals for reducing or eliminating personnel, facilities, equipment, supplies, services and funds in the schools of this city, county and state; and

WHEREAS an informed judgment upon such proposals requires that we and our representatives meet each other face-to-face in our schools and there engage in a real exchange of information about the immediate impact as well as the long-term effects of such proposals;

NOW THEN, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that each of our state and local representatives be invited to visit our schools in Sacramento, California, during Public Schools Week, April 6 through 10, 1981; and that they be welcomed back at any time thereafter in order to monitor the results of their legislative decisions.
