

RESOLUTION NO. 286

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of  
July 29, 1938

RESOLUTION CANCELLING TAXES

WHEREAS, the application of the City of Sacramento for cancellation of the taxes upon the real property hereinafter described, now owned by said City, having been presented; and

WHEREAS, it appearing that, under and by virtue of Section 3804-a, Political Code, said taxes should be cancelled;

Lot 235 "Wright & Kimbrough Tract #33"


The taxes hereinbefore referred to are hereby made to include:
