

RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT NO. 2451

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of
October 31, 1941

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the costs and expenses of improving 7TH AVENUE, from a point 14 feet west of the easterly line of 55th Street, to the sewer in place in 56th Street, approximately 10 feet east of the center line thereof; and RIGHT-OF-WAY, owned by the City of Sacramento along the rear of Lots 5, 6, 7 and 8 "Gibson Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California),

in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2451;

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this Council upon said Assessment; and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work or in said Assessment; and

WHEREAS, no appeal has been taken to this Council by any person, and the City Council has heard evidence upon said Assessment and the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, and is satisfied with the correctness of the same;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, be, and the same are, hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
