

ORDINANCE NO. 1228, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO FOR THE SERVICE OF MAKING CONNECTIONS WITH THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS OF THE SAID CITY; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1186, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 26, 1946, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Charges for connection to City Water Mains:

a. Following are the charges for Taps and Connections:

3/4" .....	\$ 15.00
1" .....	20.00
1 1/4" .....	40.00
2" .....	50.00

b. The cost of all labor and material is included in the above charge.

SECTION 2: Charges for connection to City Sewer System shall be as follows:

a. Where property owner or someone on his behalf digs to sewer and furnishes pipe.....\$ 5.00

b. Any connection into concrete sewer or manhole.....\$10.00

c. Where the City performs the digging and furnishes the pipe the charge shall be:

1. Unpaved street or alley-  
\$1.50 per linear foot of trench plus \$5.00 for the connection.

2. Paved Street or Alley-  
\$2.50 per linear foot of trench plus \$5.00 for the connection.

3. Where conditions of job cause labor charges for the work based on the prevailing scale to be in excess of the linear foot charge, the charge shall be for the labor charge at the prevailing scale plus \$5.00 for the connection.

SECTION 3: Where a building permit has been issued by the City of Sacramento prior to August 25, 1946, the previously existing schedule of fees shall apply for connection to the property for which the permit was issued.


SECTION 4: Ordinance No. 1186, Fourth Series, passed July 26, 1946, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure to take effect immediately; such emergency being that many applications have been made for water taps and it is necessary that the provisions of this ordinance become effective immediately in order to allow the installation thereof.


