**INDIVIDUAL PROJECT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT  
AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO  
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE FOR ADDITIONAL POLICE SERVICES IN THE  
ALKALI FLAT REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA**

WHEREAS, crime in the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Project Area discourages investment and endangers the safety of residents and others within the project area; and

WHEREAS, the expenditure of Alkali Flat tax increment funds for additional police services would likely decrease the incidence of crime in the project area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1: The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento hereby finds that:

- a) The funds will be spent in the Alkali Flat Project Area for the benefit of the project area.
- b) The expenditure is directly related to and constitutes redevelopment activity in that it will reduce the blighting effect of criminal activities which contributes to the deterioration of the project area.

Section 2: The Executive Director is authorized to execute an Individual Project Agreement (IPA) with the City of Sacramento Department of Police to fund two additional police officer positions for 12 months to police the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Project Area.

Section 4: The Executive Director is authorized to take all actions as necessary to implement the IPA.
