

# RESOLUTION No. 261

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 21st, 1929

BE IT RESOLVED that deed dated the 21st day of November, 1929 to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company for that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the Filtration Plant Site of the City of Sacramento, from which the concrete monument, marking the northeast corner of a tract of land deeded by Archibald Hall to A. C. McDavid by deed dated August 13, 1910, and recorded in Book 317 at Page 243, Sacramento County Records and subsequently deeded to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, bears south 639.9 feet; thence from the point of beginning East 235.0 feet along the northern boundary of the said Filtration Plant Site to a point; thence South 26 degrees 57 1/2 minutes West 518.3 feet to a point on the west boundary of the said Filtration Plant Site; thence North 462.0 feet along the west boundary of the said Filtration Plant Site to the point of beginning and containing 1.25 acres, being a triangular strip of land located in the northwest corner of the Filtration Plant Site of the City of Sacramento

be and the same is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Sacramento are hereby authorized and directed to execute said deed on behalf of the City of Sacramento.
