STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that, in the best interest of the City, the City Council adopt the specifications used in the bidding process and accept the lowest responsible bid submitted for the contract resulting from Bid No. 1673 for Suburban Carryall Type Vehicles. Award is being recommended to the following contractor: Thompson's Auto & Truck, Inc., 1412 Broadway, Placerville, CA 95667, in a total amount of \$88,379.78.

SUMMARY

Attached is a tabulation of sealed proposals received by the City Clerk for furnishing equipment in accordance with the specifications used in the bidding process, and recommendation of bid award for Bid No. 1673 for Suburban Carryall Type Vehicles being purchased by the Fleet and Facility Management Division for the Fire Department and Survey Division.

BACKGROUND

Three replacement Suburban Carryall Type Vehicles are being purchased by the Fleet and Facility Management Division of the Department of Public Works. A 1/2 ton unit is intended for use by a City survey crew and two 3/4 ton vehicles are intended for use by City Fire Department Battalion Chiefs as emergency vehicles.

Specifications for Bid No. 1673 were publicly advertised and mailed by the City Clerk. Initial advertising and mailing to vendors, bid advertising firms and minority outreach agencies began on May 3, 1995. Sealed bids were publicly opened by the City Clerk on May 24, 1995.

The following is a summary of the recommendation for contract award:

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Sufficient funds for this purchase are available in the Fleet and Facility Management Division's FY95 budget line for new and replacement vehicles.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

Ongoing administrative and maintenance activities, such as purchases of supplies, equipment or materials which are not made for purposes of a public works construction project, do not constitute a "project" and are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15061(b)(1), 15378(b)(3).

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This recommendation is consistent with the requirements for competitive bidding as detailed in Title 57 of the Sacramento City Code.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Requests for bid (RFB) were sent to sixteen vendors, two of which are M/WBE firms. The names of the M/WBE firms were obtained from the City bid list and by researching the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) Minority and Women Business Enterprise 1992-93 Directory, City of

Oakland MBE/WBE Directory, and the State of California - Winter 1995 Disadvantaged Business (DB) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE) List. In addition, this RFB was sent to several bid advertising agencies, including the Small Business Exchange and the Sacramento Minority Business Development Center (NEDA).


This bid included provisions for a five percent (5%) bid evaluation preference, not to exceed \$25,000.00, for City-certified, preference-eligible M/WBE firms. Of the two bids received, neither was from a certified Minority/Woman-Owned Business Enterprise.
